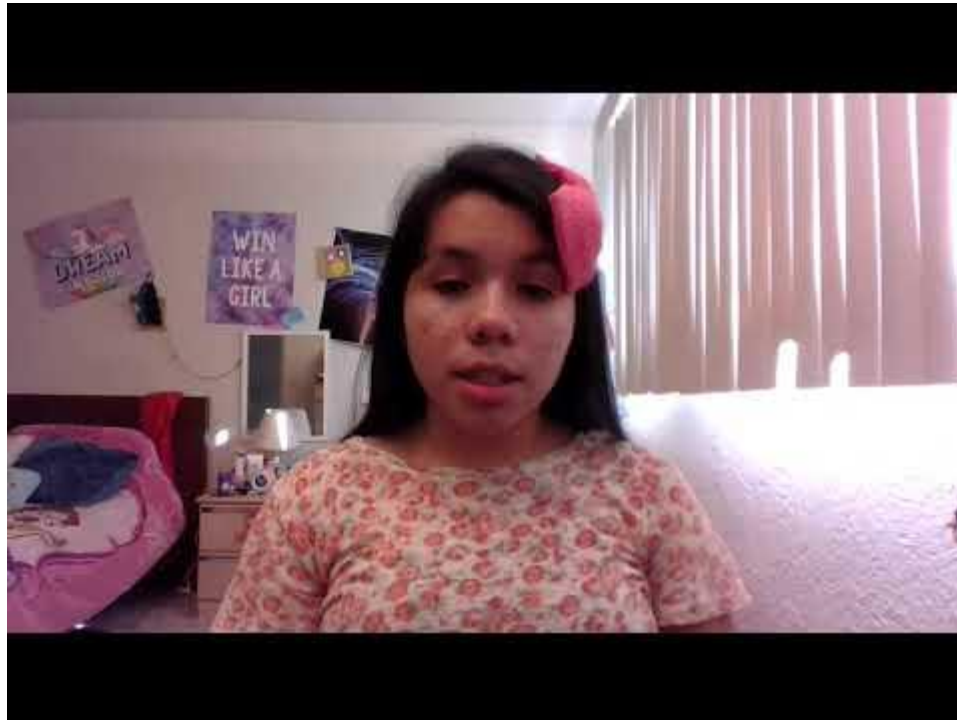

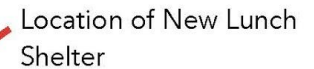

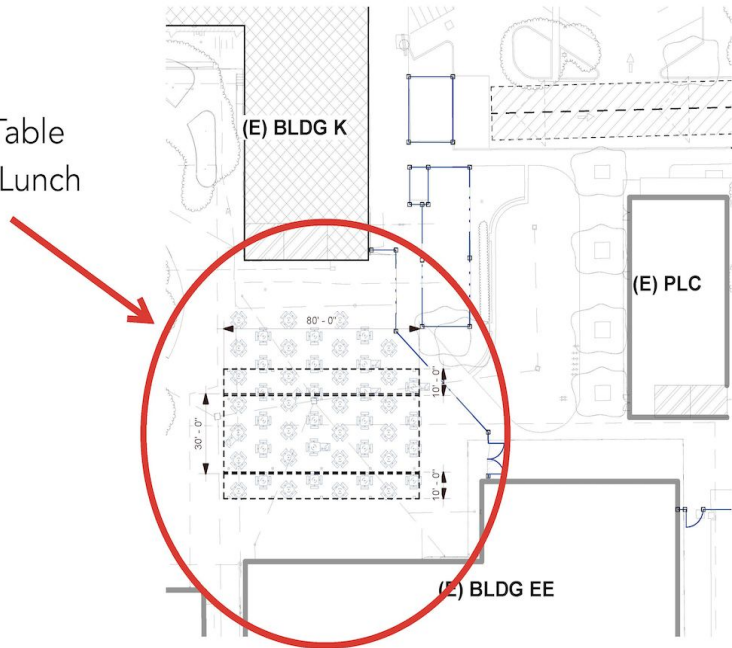

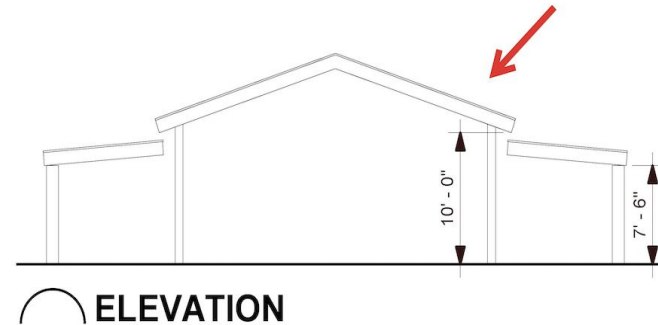

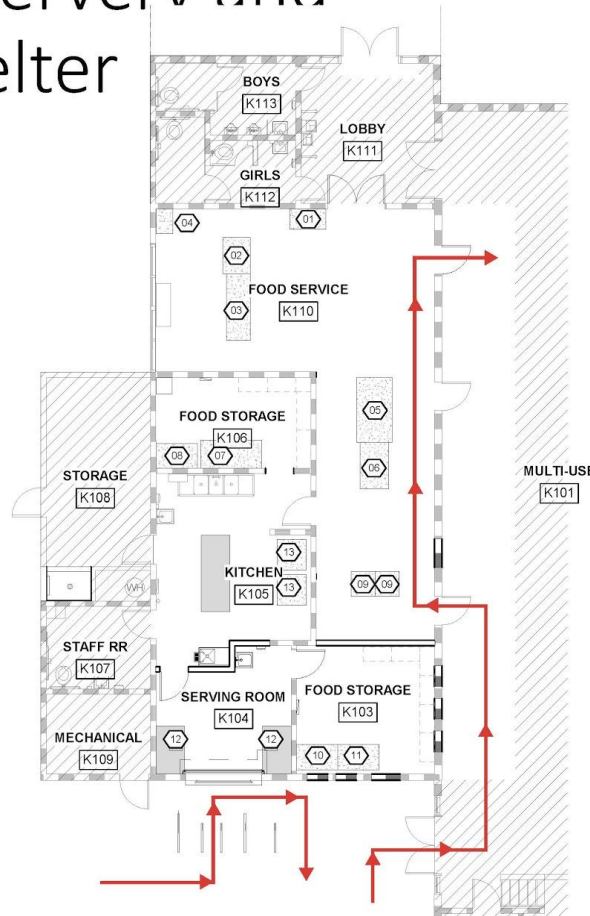


View of Lunch Shelter
